

Sample ways the intervention report can assist with you extracting student groups and/or individuals for tiered support.

#### HERO READY - Tardiness

Tier 1 – all students receive the same Hero actions until default (ex: Warning, Parent Contact, Detention, Admin Action)

Tier 2 – 11 or more tardies, students will attend an assembly by counselor, dean, and AP detailing the negative effects tardiness has on grades and how it could affect/jeopardize graduation

Tier 3 – 20+ Tardies – Students will be referred to their guidance counselor and a Parent Conference is required. The students is placed on an attendance contract and parents will call the school weekly to review attendance data with clerk.

#### HERO RISE – On Time

Tier 1 – All students are rewarded for being on time

Tier 2 – If students have fewer than 5 on time points in a quarter, students will attend an assembly by counselor, dean, and AP detailing the negative effects tardiness has on grades and how it could affect/jeopardize graduation

Tier 3 – If students have fewer than 10 on time points in a semester, Students will be referred to the SAFE Coordinator and a Parent Conference is required. The students is placed on an attendance contract and parents will call the school weekly to review attendance data with clerk.

#### HERO (Sample: Respect)

Tier 1 – All students earn points for respectful behavior

Tier 2 – At 10+ respect points in a quarter, students are invited to a special lunch with the admin team and local business leaders to network

Tier 3 – At 20+ respect points in a quarter, students are invited to receive peer mediation training and are invited to complete an individual survey about the incentive and behavior programs so admin can consider student feedback
